3. **STUDY** the Word for **Knowledge**

- A. Romans 15:4 "For whatever was written in earlier times was written for our instruction, that through perseverance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope."
- B. **II Timothy 2:15 "Study** to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, **rightly dividing the Word of truth**."

EZRA 7:8-10

8 He came to Jerusalem in the fifth month, which was in the seventh year of the king. 9 For on the first of the first month he began to go up from Babylon; and on the first of the fifth month he came to Jerusalem, because the good hand of his God was upon him. 10 For Ezra had set his heart to study the law of the Lord and to practice it, and to teach His statutes and ordinances in Israel.

1. SITUATION

- **A. FOREIGN** = Returning from a Babylon to Jerusalem
- **B. FAVOR** = with the King Artaxerxes because of his Favor with God.
 - Ezra 7:6 "This Ezra went up from Babylon, and he was a scribe skilled in the law of Moses, which the Lord God of Israel had given; and the king granted him all he requested because the hand of the Lord his God was upon him."
 - Ezra 7:21 (NASB) "I, even I, King Artaxerxes, issue a decree to all the treasurers who are in the provinces beyond the River, that whatever Ezra the priest, the scribe of the law of the God of heaven, may require of you, it shall be done diligently,
