## **Message from Laura Newell**

Recently I received praise and prayer requests from our friends in China, the ones we partner with each summer. It is rainy season there and heavy rains have brought dangerous flooding and land-slides. This does not affect city dwellers nearly as much as those in the countryside because the infrastructure in cities is much better than in towns and villages.

Current downpours and flashfloods have done heavy damage in 22 villages where up to 10,000 people have been evacuated; three people have been killed. Because of these conditions, we have been asked to pray for those especially in SW China where rain and flashfloods are expected to continue.

In addition, the director who many of us have met (she spoke a few years ago at our women's seminar), has requested prayer for her upcoming travels. Her travel dates are July 26-August 5, so she leaves next week to spend time ministering to college kids, for whom she has a special place in her heart. Years ago she came to Christ while she was a university student. Please intercede with us for traveling mercies, safety, and much fruit that remains for His glory. In addition, she will spend a few days with her family in which she is the only believer.

I saved her praise for last: the local government approached her some weeks ago with a special request to assist them. Because of Covid, there are quite a few elders in the area who have no one to help them, whether it's getting food, a ride to the doctor, or just having someone to talk to, especially in this rainy season.

It didn't take long for a plan to be put into place to train elders in the local fellowships. Many signed up to reach out to aid their peers, most of them strangers. They have been called to be Christ's hands and feet in their communities. What a privilege! I believe they are doing those "good works God planned for them beforehand."

In Chinese culture one is obligated to help family and friends but not strangers. Indeed not! But with our example of the Good Samaritan, Chinese Christians are putting their faith into action and learning that God's revelation of His thoughts are higher than their cultural traditions.

It is really unheard of for the government to ask churches for help, especially when the national government is putting church leaders and pastors into prison. This is a breakthrough, so let's rejoice with those who are rejoicing and weep with those who are weeping in the Middle Kingdom where God's Spirit is alive and well. Many thanks for your prayer support for our brothers and sisters there.
