My Neighbor by Laura Newell

My neighbor across the hall was a political science professor at our university. She and her husband were quite a bit older and her elderly father lived with them. He was a tall, elegant man with a lovely white mustache. Whenever I saw him, I smiled and nodded but there was never any response. His daughter and her husband, however, smiled and nodded in return. This couple were unique because they had joined the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) before it was organized in 1949. They were true believers in socialism; I never knew I was supposed to be a capitalist until my students informed me of my true identity. That still makes me smile.

Chinese New Year is the highlight of the calendar year, and it's when everyone travels back to their hometown, if at all possible, and celebrates with family and friends. It's considered respectful for students to visit their teachers with a gift to show their appreciation. One of our engineering students, a fairly new believer, stopped at my neighbor's apartment to wish her political science prof a "Happy New Year."

During their visit, my neighbor lowered her voice and said, "When you girls meet at your foreign teacher's apartment, you should not sing so loudly. You need to sing quietly so others cannot hear."

When this engineering student told me what my neighbor said I was ever so grateful for her warning and that she herself did not turn us in to school officials. I was reminded of my home church in San Diego because a group of women there prayed faithfully for me. They asked God to give me favor with everyone I met, especially those with whom I worked. Favor for Jesus' sake. I praise God that's exactly what He did with my neighbor because not only was I protected, but our whole Bible class was too, for His glory and our good.

Operation Christmas Child 2020

Shoeboxes are for children ages 2-4, 5-9 and 10-14.

Since 1993 Operation Christmas Child (OCC) has delivered gift filled shoeboxes to over 168 million children in more than 100 countries.

Once again this year Samaritan's Purse will be collecting shoeboxes for OCC. However, this year due to COVID 19 restrictions, PBC will not be hosting a shoebox packing event.

If you would like to participate in OCC this year you may:

- go online at samaritanspurse.org/occ and donate or fill a shoebox
- pick up a free shoebox (12 x 7 x 4 3/8 inches) and label from Niki at the church office, filling the shoebox with items from the suggested list below.

Also available for pickup are some supplies that have been donated to PBC that can be used in the shoeboxes, especially for the older kids. However, if you plan to pack a box for the 2-4 age group let Niki know and there are some supplies that we have which are appropriate for that age group.

If you would like to pick up a free shoebox and/or supplies, please contact Niki at pbcmaui@hawaii.rr.com to arrange a day/time to get these items. Please also let Niki know how many shoeboxes & supplies you would like to pick up.

You may take your packed and labeled shoebox directly to Grace Bible Church, 635 Hina Ave, Kahului, during National Shoebox Collection Week November 16-23. Specific dates and times have not yet been announced. The shoeboxes may be dropped off at Grace Bible Church during collection week only, NO other times will be available. Or, if you need assistance to take your shoeboxes to the collection site, please let Niki know so arrangements can be made for your boxes to be delivered.

Shipping is \$9.00 per box and PBC will send the money for shipping directly to Samaritan's Purse. You may make checks payable to PBC and designate OCC shipping on the memo line.
