## PEACE with GOD

**Romans 5:1-8** = 1 Therefore, having been justified by faith, <u>we have peace with God</u> <u>through our Lord Jesus Christ</u>, 2 through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand ; and we <u>exult in hope</u> of the glory of God. 3 And not only this, but we also exult in our tribulations, knowing that tribulation brings about <u>perseverance</u>; 4 and perseverance, <u>proven character</u>; and proven character, <u>hope</u>; 5 and hope does not disappoint, because the <u>love of God</u> has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us. 6 For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. 7 For one will hardly die for a righteous man ; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die. 8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

1. PEACE = **v1-2** 

A. RELATIONSHIP = with God = (AM= Peace OF God only possible when we have Peace WITH God)

B. REASON = Jesus is the Only Reason for this Peace = we have peace with God

## through our Lord Jesus Christ,

C. REJOICE = "we exult in hope of the glory of God"

## 2. PROBLEMS = v3a "And not only this, but we also exult in our tribulations,"

A. ATTITUDE = Grumble vs. Gratitude

B. ATTENTION = Focus on the PRIZE, not the PROBLEM

3. PATHWAY = v3b-4 "knowing that tribulation brings about perseverance; 4 and

perseverance, proven character; and proven character, hope;"

A. STEPPING STONE = Building of Character

B. STUMBLING BLOCK = Character Building is Hard, Painful work = Growth thru Failure

4. PASSION = v5-8 = Love of God for us = 5 and hope does not disappoint, because the <u>love of God</u> has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.
6 For <u>while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ</u> died for the ungodly.
7 For one will hardly die for a righteous man ; though

perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die. 8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

- A. SPIRIT = "5 and hope does not disappoint, because the <u>love of</u> <u>God</u> has been poured out within our hearts through the <u>Holy Spirit</u> who was given to us."
- B. SETTING = "6 For while we were still helpless,"
- C. SACRIFICE = "...<u>at the right time Christ died for the ungodly</u>."
- D. SAVIOR = . "7 For one will hardly die for a righteous man ; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die. 8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."
