## A SPECIAL SKEPTIC

**John 20:24-29** = Thomas & His Doubts

**24** But **Thomas**, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Jesus came.

- 1. SEPARATION = "was not with them"
  - **A. MISSING** = from the Fellowship of Believers
  - **B. MOTIVATION** = Many reasons why he decided not to be there: Fear, Disappointment, Anger, Conflict, Loss of Interest, etc.

25 So the other disciples were saying to him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said to them, "Unless I see in His hands the imprint of the nails, and put my finger into the place of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe." 26 After eight days His disciples were again inside, and Thomas with them. Jesus came, the doors having been shut, and stood in their midst and said, "Peace be with you."

- 2. SKEPTICISM = We often Mock Thomas and call him "Doubting
  - **Thomas"** because of this but 2 IMPORTANT TRUTHS
  - **A. INITIATIVE** = to Return to the Fellowship
  - **B. INDIVIDUALLY = RECEIVE or REJECT JESUS**

27 Then He said to Thomas, "Reach here with your finger, and see My hands; and reach here your hand and put it into My side; and do not be unbelieving, but believing."
28 Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!"
29 Jesus said to him, "Because you have seen Me, have you believed? Blessed are they who did not see, and yet believed."

## 3. SELECTED

- A. SEEKS = Luke 19:10 "For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."
- **B. SAVES** = from our sins & eternal separation they bring in Hell
- C. SPECIAL = <sup>29</sup> Jesus said to him, "Because you have seen Me, have you believed?

  BLESSED ARE THEY WHO DID NOT SEE, AND YET BELIEVED."

  THIS IS US = YOU AND ME!!!
